- Wall graphics have been installed in the History Center. Up lighting (lights shining up on walls) have been acquired for adding to the ambience for events held at the History Center.
- Democratic Election Party was held in the History Center many good compliments were received.

Programs Report – Kristin Krzic

- TCHA's 90th birthday celebration will be held Dec. 2 at the History Center.
- Book talk and signing by the author Dr. Michael Townsley only had 3 people attend. Advertising was by social media. No e-mail blast was received.
- Fighting for Freedom is the name of the diversity program for 2019; Tuesday and Wednesday Feb 19-20 2019. Goal is 500 bookings of students and \$20,000 in sponsorships.
- School programs with Happy Hollow 4 classes total with 1 class per day \$885 made
- Program Brochure release will be late January 2019
- SIA Japanese Festival for 2019 Craig has submitted a \$5500 sponsorship request to SIA. TCHA will sell tickets to this event.

Collections Committee – Kelly Lippie

- Volunteers are scanning photograph collection, indexing J&C negative collection, and processing archival collections
- 2nd Tuesday of the month at 11:30 AM is the Collections Department meetings for all volunteers.

- Gathered images for photo mural for the History Center
- Helped winterize Blockhouse. Brought furs back to Arganbright for winter storage.

- 21 items were put up for deaccession. All were accepted for deaccession by vote from the Board.

Battlefield Museum Report – Rick Conwell

- Taxable sales reached \$50K for the year weekend of November 3-4, 2018. On track.
- Nov 7th was 207th anniversary of Battle of Tippecanoe. Battle Ground elementary 4th graders visited museum.
- Saturday, Nov 10th was official commemoration at Battlefield. Reenactors and presentations by 3 individuals representing: Native Americans in Battle, American soldiers at Battle, and WWI soldiers (100th anniversary of WWI Armistice in November 1918). Double taps were played.
- Museum is slowing, as expected, in November after commemoration weekend. Museum is closed December 24 to January 11th and Holiday hours are in effect until February 28th.

Feast Report - Leslie Martin Conwell

- Grounds clean up went on into November; parking area was a mess
- Feast bills are still being paid. Food booth bills still being determined. Figures should be available for January 8th, 2019 meeting of Board.
