If you are sick or feel like you might be getting sick, or if a member of your household is sick, please do not enter the Arganbright Library or Battlefield Museum. If you are trying to conduct research at the library, please call us to ask about how we can help with off-site research.

TCHA is closely monitoring the progress of COVID-19 and will follow all public safety recommendations from the CDC and Indiana State Department of Health regarding our hours and operations.
