TIPPECANOE COUNTY INDIGENT SOLDIER BURIALS 1889 to 1894

One recently located source we have discovered here at the Alameda McCullough Research Library is a book containing burial records for deceased Indigent Union Civil War veterans. The records consist of a ledger book as well as a number of individual certificates.

These records were created as a result of an Act passed by the Indiana General Assembly in 1889 which made it the duty of the Township Trustees to provide a "decent and respectable burial" for any Union soldier, sailor, or marine who had been honorably discharged and who had died without the necessary means to provide for funeral & burial. It was noted in the law that the Trustee was to determine the need and if the need was verified the county was obligated to pay up to \$50 for said funeral & or burial. The burials were to be done in any cemetery excluding those used exclusively for pauper burials.

This ledger book contains the names of about 60 deceased soldiers, sailors, or marines who died between 1889 and 1894 in Tippecanoe County.

The book and receipts give information on the names.

Occupation and his age

Additionally it provides the description and cost of service provided by the county.
